

Thermoguard RoHS Declaration according to the Directive 2002/95/EC

Thermoguard declares hereby, that all products delivered in the European Community and Switzerland after July 1st are in full compliance with the Directive 2002/95/EC titled "Restriction of certain Hazardous Substances", RoHS.

According to the scope of the RoHS Directive, electronic products may not exceed the limits given for following elements and substances

Lead (Pb):	1'000 ppm
Mercury (Hg):	1'000 ppm
Cadmium (Cd):	100 ppm
Hexavalent Chromium (Cr ⁶⁺):	1'000 ppm
Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB):	1'000 ppm
Polybrominated Diphenylethers (PBDE):	1'000 ppm

An excess of the indicated maximum concentration values by weight in homogenous materials must be avoided, unless the substance is subject to an exemption specified in the Directive.

Excepted from this Directive are medical and military products, monitoring and controlling instruments as well as spare parts dedicated for repair of electronic products sold before July 1st 2006.
